

## MATHS

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In the Maths folder, you will find work organised by **year group**. Click on the folder for the year group you are in....

**YEARS 7 and 8:** Folders contain work **by topic** that we would like you to work through **at your own pace**. There is also a word document with links/instructions of how to access Maths websites you may find useful.

**YEARS 9 and 10:** This folder has sub-folders containing practice papers (including mark schemes/solutions), revision booklets and revision sheets. You will need to select resources for the **tier** you are following e.g. Foundation or Higher. Work through these resources at your own pace but try to mix and match the type of activity you complete each day. There is also a word document with links/instructions of how to access Maths websites you may find useful.

**YEAR 11:** There will be a word document in this folder for each class e.g. 'Mrs Baxter 11R1' which will contain specific instructions and direction from your class teacher. The folder also contains sub-folders with practice papers (including mark schemes/solutions), revision booklets and revision sheets. You will need to select resources for the **tier** you are following e.g. Foundation or Higher - you can work through these resources at your own pace but try to mix and match the type of activity you complete each day. There is also a word document with links/instructions of how to access Maths websites you may find useful.

## ENGLISH

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In the English area, you will find work in a folder called English 2020. It is organised by **year group**. Click on the folder for the year group you are in....

**YEARS 7, 8 and 9:** Folders contain work that continues your current topics that we would like you to work through at your own pace.

**YEAR 10:** This folder has sub-folders containing various revision materials relating to English Literature exams. Work through these resources at your own pace. Try to cover different topics, rather than spending all of your time on only one area.

**YEAR 11:** This folder has sub-folders containing various practice papers for English Language Paper 1 and Paper 2 exams. Each one will take around 2 hours to complete. Focus on the areas you feel would be most beneficial.

## SCIENCE

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In the Science folder, you will find work organised by **year group**. Click on the folder for the year group you are in....

**YEARS 7 and 8:** Folders contain work that we would like you to work through **at your own pace**. There is also a pdf file with information that will help you to answer the questions on the worksheets.

**YEARS 9 and 10:** These folders have sub-folders for Biology, Chemistry and Physics. Work through the resources inside those sub-folders at your own pace but try to mix and match the subjects you work on each day.

**YEAR 11:** This folder has sub-folders for Biology, Chemistry and Physics. Work through the resources inside those sub-folders at your own pace but try to mix and match the subjects you work on each day. There are also extra resources to help you independently revise in preparation for your exams. Please also use the BBC Bitesize website (remember we're Edexcel exam board) and you may find [www.freesciencelessons.co.uk](http://www.freesciencelessons.co.uk) useful for extra help and support.

## R.E.

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In the RE folder, you will find work organised by **year group**. Click on the folder for the year group you are in....

**YEARS 7, 8 and 9:** Folders contain work **by topic** that we would like you to work through at your own pace and research carefully. There is a Microsoft Word document with links/instructions of how to access videos and websites you may find useful.

**YEAR 10:** This folder includes the following...

- A3 revision sheets, one-page revision sheets and worksheets
- Sample exam papers

Some of the Adobe files may need a password, if they do please use **zz2ghc4**

Use the A3 sheets to recap/revise topics and also answer the worksheets

Once you have done this give the exams a try. Remember to use the techniques your teacher has already worked with you to develop.

**YEAR 11:** This folder includes the following...

## GEOGRAPHY

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In the Geography folder, you will find work organised by **year group**. Click on the folder for the year group you are in....

**YEARS 7 and 8:** Folders contain work **by topic** that we would like you to work through **at your own pace**. Your teacher will tell you which topic you should be working on.

**YEAR 9:** This folder has an instruction sheet and revision booklet for you to work through based on Tropical Rainforests. Work through these resources at your own pace but try to mix and match the type of activity you complete each day.

**YEARS 10:** This folder has an instruction sheet and revision booklet for you to work through based on Urban Environments. Work through these resources at your own pace but try to mix and match the type of activity you complete each day.

**YEAR 11:** There is a Year 11 task sheet word document in this folder which contains specific instructions and direction from your class teacher of which topics to revise. The folder also contains practice papers and revision booklets. You can work through these resources at your own pace but try to mix and match the type of activity you complete each day. Use this time wisely to aid revision.

## HISTORY

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In the History folder, you will find work organised by **year group**. Click on the folder for the year group you are in....

**YEARS 7 and 8:** You will find a PowerPoint slide with instructions for a Pre-1066 project. Please choose a task and complete it. If you would like to complete more than one, there are lots of different options.

**YEAR 9:** You will find a Medicine folder containing practice questions and papers, mark schemes, revision booklets and the two textbooks we use for each topic. Work through these resources at your own pace and have a go at the exam questions then use the mark schemes to check. Use the text books if you have any knowledge gaps.

**YEAR 10:** You will find folders for Medicine, American West and Race Relations containing practice questions and papers, mark schemes, revision booklets and the two textbooks we use for each topic. Work through these resources at your own pace and have a go at the exam questions then use the mark schemes to check. Use the text books if you have any knowledge gaps.

**YEAR 11:** You will find folders for Medicine, American West, Elizabeth and Race Relations containing practice questions and papers, mark schemes, revision booklets and the two textbooks we use for each topic. Work through these resources at your own pace and have a go at the exam questions then use the mark schemes to check. Use the text books if you have any knowledge gaps.

## SPANISH

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In the Spanish folder pupils will find work organised by year group. Click on the folder for the year group you are in....

**YEARS 7 and 8:** Folders contain a word document with lists of tasks for you to do at your own pace. There is a document labelled "grammar table" which you can complete to revise verb endings. In addition, there is also a sub-folder labelled "vocabulary" which contains vocabulary for you to revise but also as reference material to support you. There is also a list of different websites you can access too. If a class teacher needs to provide specific tasks to their class, a sub-folder under the class teacher's name will be created. Example "Ms Rubio 8R2".

**YEARS 9 and 10:** These folders contain a word document with all the tasks listed. You should work through these at your own pace. You will also find sub-folders with lots of other activities; such as questions to prepare from your speaking booklet, mind maps to support you when answering the questions and vocabulary to revise.

**YEAR 11:** This folder contains a word document with all the tasks listed. You should work through these at your own pace. You will also find sub-folders to help you revise for your exams. These sub-folders include speaking exam practice, grammar practice and also past papers which are divided into tiers – Higher and Foundation. You should also have your 'purple workbooks' to work your way through.

## MEDIA STUDIES

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In the Media Studies folder, you will find work in a folder called Media 2020. It is organised by **year group**. Click on the folder for the year group you are in....

**YEARS 9 and 10:** Folders contain work that enable you to continue working through the course at your own pace.

**YEAR 11:** This folder has an instruction sheet which outlines the work you will need to complete. Open this word document first in order to check what you will need to work on and to help you prioritise your efforts.

## SEN

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This folder contains links to websites containing resources that may be suitable for students with special or additional needs.

## BUSINESS STUDIES

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In the Business folder, work is organised in Student Resources: Business then into the relevant Key Stage (KS3 for year 9 and KS4 for years 10 and 11). Please click on the appropriate Key Stage, then on the appropriate year folder. For each year the folder containing your work is called Remote Access Work.

**YEAR 9:** You need to revise all of the revision materials supplied in lesson for the mock examination and also in the mock examination folder saved in student resources/Business/ KS3/ year9/Remote Access Work/Exam. Access student resources/Business/KS3/year9/RemoteAccess/Coursework. This is an extended marketing project with many areas to cover such as the PEST, SWOT, 4Ps, Promotional activities etc. You must work through the project. Once complete, save in your area ready for printing upon return to school and email to your teacher.

**YEAR 10:** There are sub folders in Student Resources/Business/KS4/Year 10 /Remote Access/Component 1 and Component 3 which contain tasks, information presentations etc. **Component 1** tasks – SMEs, Market Research and SWOT/PESTLE. There are step by step guidance and assignment for this component (all 3 tasks). **Component 3** – Learning Aim A, there is a teacher support presentation and a workbook (the same as the one you have been given in class). There is also a marketing segmentation presentation for guidance. You must work through the booklet. Save into you own area for printing. Finally, you must complete the assessment document.

**YEAR 11:** All instructions and support documents are saved in Student resources: Business/KS4/Year 11/ Remote Access work - in folders 2A, 2B and 2C. **TASKS:** complete 2A, (your business plan for a mini enterprise). Next, Component 2B - create a presentation for your mini enterprise to sell me your idea - it must have speaker notes i.e. the words you would say to me if you were in front of me. Save it in your school folder and email me a copy. My email address is [tracy.goodrick@venerablebede.co.uk](mailto:tracy.goodrick@venerablebede.co.uk) I will email feedback to help you complete Unit 2C. Tasks are in the 2C - Using my emailed feedback you must improve you presentation and speaker notes – SAVING WITH A DIFFERENT NAME e.g. *Final unit 2C presentation*. You must create a final report where you review your work and presentation. Email me this too when complete

## ART, DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY (including Health & Social Care)

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**YEARS 7 and 8:** There is a 35-page document for pupils to follow which covers all areas of Art, Design & Technology. Each page has between 30 and 60 minutes worth of work.

**YEARS 9, 10 and 11:** Within this area there are sub folders for each specialism i.e. Art, Food, Fashion, Resistant Materials, Textiles and Health & Social Care. Within each specialism there is a folder for each year group with instruction sheets for the work you will need to complete.

## COMPUTER SCIENCE

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**YEAR 7:** Work through your student and homework booklets. Tasks include researching Scratch and completing the worksheet pages then creating a game in Scratch and reviewing it. Research, then plan and create an APP using power point on an appropriate topic. You need to save this into your area for assessment and printing or email your teacher your work. The booklets are saved in STUDENT RESOURCES/KS3/YEAR7/REMOTE ACCESS WORK/STUDENT BOOKLET V9 if you do not have your printed booklet at home (Homework booklet starts on page 30 of the presentation).

**YEAR 8:** You need to research animations/sound and complete the appropriate pages in your workbook – if possible, use Flash to create an animation. Next, you need to research, plan and create a website – use PowerPoint to do this – it must have at least 4 pages on an appropriate topic. You can then evaluate your website and make improvements. You need to save this into your area for assessment and printing or email your teacher your work. Your booklet and homework booklet (starts on 29 of the presentation saved in STUDENT RESOURCES/KS3/YEAR8/REMOTE ACCESS WORK/STUDENT BOOKLET)

## MUSIC

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In the Music folder, you will find work organised by **year group**. Click on the folder for the year group you are in....

**YEARS 7 and 8:** Folders contain work **by topic** that we would like you to work through **at your own pace**.

**YEARS 9:** This folder has some documents with lists of recommended listening from the 4 areas of study.

**YEAR 10:** The folder contains sub-folders with electronic revision resources for the 2 study pieces. You can work through these resources at your own pace but try to mix and match the type of activity you complete each day.

**YEAR 11:** The folder also contains sub-folders with electronic revision resources for the 2 study pieces. You can work through these resources at your own pace but try to mix and match the type of activity you complete each day.

## ASSESSMENT P.E.

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**YEARS 9, 10 and 11:** All resources for both the GCSE PE and BTEC pathways can be found in Student Resources in the PE folder. Select the 'Home Learning' folder and follow the links/folders for the appropriate pathway and year group.

## DIGITAL I.T.

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In the ICT folder, work is organised in Student Resources: ICT then into the relevant Key Stage (KS3 for years 7, 8 and 9 and KS4 for years 10 and 11). Please click on the appropriate Key Stage then on the year folder. For each year the folder containing your work is called Remote Access Work.

**YEAR 9:** You have additional revision work which is part of your component 3 unit for you to use to create your own revision notes, mind maps etc. and questions for you to answer in the Exam folder. Also in the Impact of Modern Technology on the wider world folder there is new theory work for Component 3 where you can create some presentations on the impact of modern technology. This can be on paper or electronic documents.

**YEAR 10:** You can continue with your Unit 1B project to plan for and to create a draft for a user interface for the stadium. Instructions are on the student instruction document and examples are in BTEC LAB.ppt - Lastly, evaluate your performance in this project and discuss what you could improve in the evaluation. All tasks are in Component 1 folder. You are to email your teacher your completed work please for marking and feedback. You can then improve your work using the feedback.

**YEAR 11** - You are to complete creating your Dashboard for assignment 2B. The tasks are in the PowerPoint student instruction sheet. Instructions on how to create pivot charts are on the help sheet and the teacher power point is also in the folder. There is a video link on the power point to help. You have to add screen shots of your work on your evidence document and annotate for every chart you create. Then you need to email your Dashboard and document to me to mark. Next, you can complete 2C which is the evaluation of your Dashboard and how it analyses the trends and patterns of the data also to evaluate your own performance.

## TRAVEL & TOURISM

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Within the Geography folder, you will find a sub-folder named **Travel and Tourism** where work is organised by **year group**. Click on the folder for the year group you are in....

**YEAR 9:** This folder has an instruction sheet based on a UK holiday destination. Work through this at your own pace but try to complete as much as you. This can be emailed to Mrs Pallas to use in the classroom when we return.

**YEAR 10:** This folder has an instruction sheet and copy of the textbook pages to work through and also some revision material for the upcoming exams. Work through these resources at your own pace. Remember that your exam will hopefully be in May and you need to revise as much as you can.
