Dear Parent/Carer

As we approach the end of the spring term, I would like to thank you for your continued support. It has been a busy term since Christmas. Luckily this year we seem to have escaped the snow!

Term ends this Friday at 3.00 p.m., and we re-open on Tuesday 23 April 2019 at our usual time, with breakfast club from 7.45 a.m. and main school from 8.30 a.m. Our School Office will be open between 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. during the Easter vacation, with the exception of the Bank Holiday weekend. As we welcome in the summer term, I would like to remind parents and pupils that our summer uniform is able to be worn after the Easter break. The school polo shirt can be worn in place of the normal school shirt and tie. Polo shirts can be worn either inside or outside of trousers and skirts. The summer term is where all of the hard work and determination of Y11 is focussed on exams and making preparations for them moving into the next phase of their careers and lives. I would encourage our Y11 to make the most of the time they have left and prepare as well as they can for what lies ahead. There are revision and intervention sessions scheduled in school over the Easter break and all pupils should be doing some revision at home during this time. The bulk of the GCSE exams are only a few weeks after we return in April. I would like to wish all of our Y11 good luck in their GCSE exams.

As one year group prepares to move on from our academy, another prepares to join. Once again we look forward to welcoming a new Y7 cohort into our family. They will complete their induction in the second half of the summer term. I can confirm that we are fully subscribed for our new intake.

I would like to thank the overwhelming majority of parents who always park sensibly outside of school.
