

Dear parents/carers

From September 2020 pupils in Y7 & Y8 will need to bring a working set of headphones or earphones to Music lessons. These need to be headphones with a standard mini-jack cable (not Bluetooth or Apple style lightning connector).

Please note that although previously headphone use has been encouraged, from September 2020 it will be compulsory. If pupils do not bring their own headphones to their Music lesson, they will be given a pair of earphones to use each week and these must be stored in their music folder between lessons. If pupils do not have working headphones they will not be able to take part in the practical elements of the lesson.

GCSE Music pupils and students who take up keyboard lessons will also need to bring headphones to their lessons.

Students are encouraged to bring their own musical instruments into school for their peripatetic music lessons. Students must ensure they are dropped off in the music department on the day of their lesson and collected at the end of the same day. All peripatetic lessons will restart from Monday 21st September 2020.
