Dear Parents/Carers and Year 11 Pupils,

GCSE RESULTS DAY – THURSDAY 12th AUGUST 2021

As you will be aware, Year 11 pupils will receive their GCSE results on **Thursday 12th August 2021**. School will be open to all Year 11 pupils between **9am and 11am** on Thursday 12th August so that they can collect their GCSE results.

In order to maintain social distancing, pupils must queue outside of school before entering via the main entrance; white lines have been painted on the ground to indicate a safe social distance when queuing. Entry and exit to school will be via a one-way system - pupils will enter the Bistro, where results will be distributed, via the Technology corridor and leave through the rear Bistro exit.

We ask that pupils adhere to the social distancing protocols that are in place; hand sanitiser will be available; masks should be worn (as per Government recommendations for crowded and enclosed spaces), and we would also ask that they bring a pen with them to sign the collection log. Collection points will be clearly marked, **pupils should go to the table for the initials of their surname**.

Once a pupil has collected their GCSE results, they will be able to remain in school to open their envelope should they wish to do so. We are setting up the Sports Hall so that pupils can sit down, open their results, and be with their friends - all at a safe social distance. It is also OK if a pupil chooses to open their results once they have left the school building.

In order to reduce the number of people in the building and reduce the likelihood of any transmission of coronavirus, it is with regret that we will not be able to welcome parents/carers into the school building on results day this year. We understand that parents/carers may wish to accompany their children to receive their results, however we respectfully ask that all adults remain either in their vehicle or at a safe social distance until pupils emerge from the building.















If a pupil needs someone else (including family members) to collect their results on their behalf, they must send in a signed letter of authorisation with the person collecting. The collector will also need to provide photographic ID. If this is the case, pupils should email **exams@venerablebede.co.uk** using a school email account so that we have verification of your intention. If this process is not carried out, we cannot release results to any third party as results belong to an individual pupil.

We will of course update you should there be any change to the current plans. We look forward to seeing Year 11 on results day.
