The current Year 7 curriculum has been designed so that pupils experience a broad and balanced curriculum which builds on their learning from Key Stage 2. To support the transition from Primary school, pupils are taught in mixed ability groupings, based on their tutor groups for the first half term. After the October half term, pupils are then taught in sets. These are based on their cognitive ability, Key Stage 2 scores and the knowledge and skills they have developed during the first half term.

Year 7 Cognitive Ability Tests

A big thank you to all pupils in Year 7 for the mature and positive way in which they tackled the recent Cognitive Ability Tests (CATs). The information we receive gives us an indication as to each pupils' preferred learning profile and their overall cognitive ability – unfortunately, this information is provided in the form of spreadsheets of standardised scores and not in a way that can be meaningfully communicated to parents/carers. CATs scores are just one of the tools we use to help inform groupings. For any pupil who has missed any/all of the three assessment sessions, we will be running a catch-up assessment session after half term – should this provide us with any information that would indicate that they would benefit from being in a different set, we will of course be in touch to discuss any changes needed.

Year 7 New Groupings

On Monday 31st October, we will send you, via Parentmail, details of the curriculum group that your child will be moving to, from Wednesday 2nd November. Curriculum groupings have been determined using Key Stage 2 scores, the knowledge and skills they have developed during the first half term and your child's cognitive ability. It is important to note that class groupings are always fluid and regularly reviewed so that we can ensure the best provision for all pupils. Your child will receive a copy of their new timetable during their Period 1, Personal development lesson on Wednesday 2nd November. From Period 2 that day, pupils will follow their new timetable.

Year 7 Curriculum Plans & Progress
