Dear Parent / Carer Re: **NEU Strike Action on Tuesday 28 February 2023**

As you are aware, the NEU (National Education Union) gave notice of strike action which may affect a further 3 school days over the next 2 months. As you are aware, there are a number of things that we have to take into account before making a decision as to whether or not we can open the school to pupils on those days, particularly questions around Health and Safety and whether we will have enough staff to be able to manage the school day safely.

Due to staffing numbers, we are **NOT ABLE TO OPEN** to pupils on **Tuesday 28 February** with the exception "Vulnerable Pupils" identified by school.

Vulnerable pupils will fall into one of the following groups:

- A pupil Looked After by the Local Authority
- A pupil who is on the Safeguarding register
- A pupil who has an EHCP
- A pupil with identified high level SEND needs

A space for these pupils to work in school will be made available if it is required. These pupils will not attend lessons in their usual classrooms, but will follow their usual timetable via TEAMS lessons in a computer room. Pupils attending school will be expected to wear full school uniform. There will be no school lunches available on Tuesday 28 February. All pupils will be required to bring a packed lunch to school with them.

For pupils who qualify for free school meals, the daily allowance will be paid in a single payment for the strike days to parents / carers. This payment will be made via a voucher for a local supermarket. We are unable to send this payment direct to bank accounts any more.

As we are unable to issue a voucher for a daily amount of £2.40, the three remaining strike days will be added together, and a voucher issued for the full amount once we know if all the strike days are going ahead. The voucher will be issued directly to pupils the day after the final strike day takes place.

We realise that times are difficult at the moment, so please contact us if you require the £2.40 to be issued prior to 28th February or if you are struggling financially and would like to speak to someone in school. We can offer some support which would, of course, be kept confidential. In the first instance, please contact the school office within office hours.

Arrangements for Tuesday 28 February:

The school will be closed to pupils on **Tuesday 28 February only**. We will be open every other day that week. Pupils who have been identified as vulnerable, and who have been invited to work in school will start school at the usual time of 8.30 a.m. When these pupils arrive at school, they should report to the Main School Office to be signed in and registered. They will then be taken to the room in which they will work that day.

As far as possible, all other pupils will be able to log on to TEAMS, from home, using their school Email account and take part in “TEAMS lessons” with staff who are teaching in school. Pupils have had training on how to do this when they joined school, but here is a [LINK](#) to the resources page of the school website, where you will find all key information needed to access TEAMS lessons, FOLDR and how to learn remotely. TEAMS lessons are scheduled to begin at 9.15 a.m. which will coincide with the start of Period 1. During the day, lessons will begin and end at their usual scheduled time ([CLICK LINK](#) to School Day).

What we do not know, is how many teachers will be in school and available to deliver TEAMS lessons. The rules of the strike action are such that teaching staff are not obliged to tell school, in advance, whether they are available on Tuesday 28 February. Other teachers might also be absent due to illness that day, or might need to be absent from work to look after younger children whose school may also be closed. This means pupils will need to log on to Teams to see if their teacher is available.

Following feedback from parents from the last strike day, we are going to share our “**Curriculum Enrichment activities**” with pupils. These can be completed by pupils **AS AN ALTERNATIVE TO** Teams lessons. Pupils can hand in any work that they complete this way to their form tutor. These activities will be placed into a folder within the student resources area of FOLDR, as well as **emailed via the ParentMail** platform.

We are hopeful that the vast majority of lessons will be able to be delivered on TEAMS. In this way, we hope that all pupils will be able to engage in meaningful learning throughout the day.
