Their free parent accounts allow you to track your child's learning/revision or learn alongside your child. This can help make conversations about school, learning and revision easier.

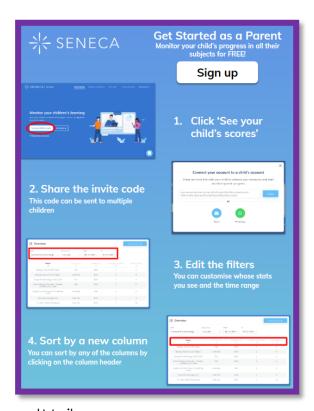
